Why does my child need a personal Opal card?

Students use personal Opal cards when they travel by train to an excursion or sport event.



Where do I buy an Opal card?

Opal cards can be purchased:

- over the counter at Opal retailers, examples include a newsagency or local mixed business.
- on the Opal website
- at selected Transport Customer Service Centres
- at selected Service NSW locations

How much will it cost?

The Child Opal card can be purchased with a minimum of \$10.
